ANNUNCIATION CENTER

Featuring a modern, sleek, open floor plan and state-of-the-art technology, the Center offers a sophisticated space to host meetings, training sessions, receptions, lectures and cultural events. The floor-to-ceiling windows in the upper and lower lobbies overlook our beautifully landscaped grounds and rolling hills.

DOLAN PERFORMANCE HALL

Located on the ground floor of Annunciation Center, Dolan Performance Hall offers a grand, yet intimate, atmosphere with an unobstructed view of the stage.

- Seating capacity of 560
- Splendid acoustics
- State-of-the-art audiovisual technology
- Perfect for large meetings, music performances, plays and lectures

THERESE A. MALONEY ART GALLERY

Located on the main floor of Annunciation Center, the Therese A. Maloney Art Gallery hosts high caliber, themed exhibitions that correspond to the curricula and events on campus. *Note: Gallery rentals for private events are restricted to the summer months.*

- Approximately 900 square feet
- Moveable interior walls
- 200 running feet for hanging and display of different types of art
- Perfect for lectures, gallery talks, workshops and panel discussions by artists and arts professionals

FLEX ROOMS/CLASSROOMS

Flexibility of three individual rooms or combine into one large event space, our Flex rooms can be set in classroom, theater, banquet, U-shaped, hollow square or vendor display configurations. In addition, Annunciation Center offers a variety of lecture-style classrooms.

- Flex rooms: individual 22' x 28' or combined 68' x 28'
- Lecture-style classrooms: capacity from 20 to 60
- State-of-the-art technology and WiFi access

Saint Joseph Hall, perfect for a traveling basketball/volleyball team or a town hall meeting.

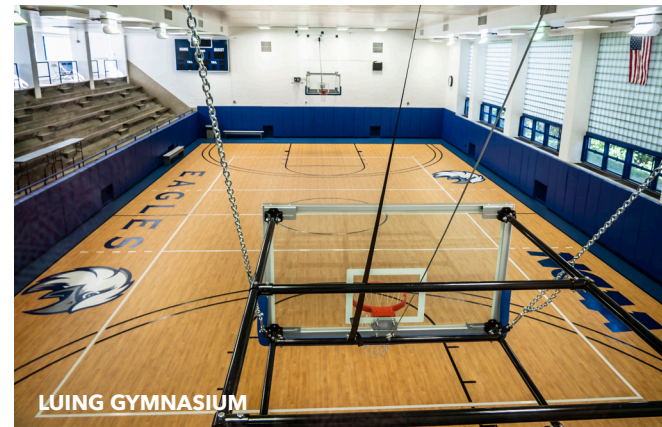
GYMNASIUMS

WARD DINING ROOM

- Can be divided into a 20' x 22' or 38' x 22' room or combined to 58' x 22'. Perfect for training sessions, meetings, meal functions.
- Can be set up in multiple configurations: classroom, theater, banquet, U-shaped, hollow square or vendor display configurations.



ANASTASIA HEALTH SCIENCES CENTER

Located in Henderson Hall, the new Anastasia Health Sciences Center, available on a limited basis, is a state-of-the-art interactive facility for health profession education and training.

- Clinical Assessment Lab, featuring a 12-bed patient simulation room
- Patient Evaluation Clinic, including six fully equipped examination rooms
- High-fidelity computerized mannequins simulating real-life health care scenarios
- Anatomage Table, a life-size interactive dissection table that allows students to visualize anatomy down to the cellular level
- Science laboratories for biology and chemistry

CLASSROOMS

Newly renovated air-conditioned classrooms offer a variety of capacity and configurations equipped with 80" smart televisions that interactively connect to the podium or a laptop.

- HH23/HH25: moveable table seating up to 32 as separate divided rooms or 64 when combined
- HH201: banked seating with capacity of 66 featuring built-in power and USB ports on tables
- HH210: auditorium seating with capacity of 128
- Hyland Hall: auditorium seating with capacity of 206 (overhead projector and screen)

The Greek Theatre, built in 1932, remains one of only a handful of outdoor amphitheatres in the United States.

- Outdoor facility inspired by the Theatre of Dionysius in Athens
- Ample parking for trailers, production crew trucks and equipment

- Proximity to New York
- New Jersey Transit station at entrance to campus
- Perfect for plays, concerts, and picnics

SHAKESPEARE GARDEN

Created in 1925 by Sister Angela Dorey, the first religious Sister in the United States to receive her Ph.D.
