- Completed application
- Official transcripts from all prior institutions (these may be sent after you submit your online application)
- Two letters of recommendation (three letters of recommendation for doctoral programs)
- Personal statement (500 words or one to two pages)

You may upload your unofficial transcripts, recommendation letters, and personal statement as part of your application. Admission to an SEU master's program requires a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution (or a comparable degree if outside the US).

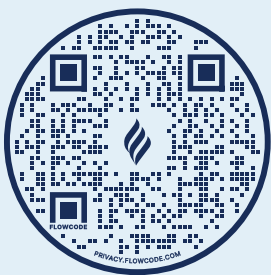

SAINT ELIZABETH UNIVERSITY HAS RECEIVED A GRANT TO SUPPORT HISPANIC STUDENTS PURSUING HEALTH CARE CAREERS

Recently, SEU, as one of 12 higher education Hispanic Serving Institutions (HSI) nationwide, was awarded a two-year \$200,000 grant from Bank of America to support Hispanic-Latinx graduate students pursuing careers in healthcare through its Progresando initiative. This initiative, called the Progresando Grant, is a multiyear commitment to help SEU students achieve upward economic mobility through careers in healthcare. It is also helping to increase representation and address the shortage of culturally sensitive, Spanish-speaking health providers.

We are within a 90-mile radius of Philadelphia and one train ride from New York City!

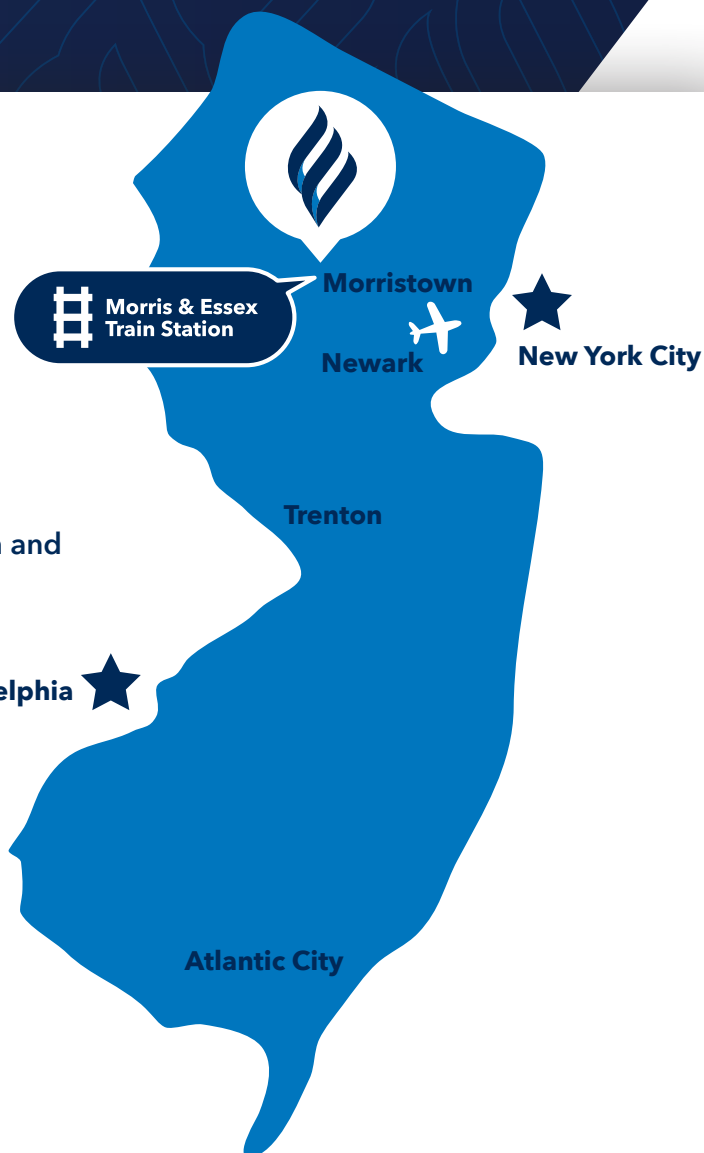
