
Speak Now Camp:

Summer Camp for Adolescents Who Stutter



Speak Now Camp was developed in 2014 to provide young people who stutter (ages 8-16) and their families with a supportive environment where they can develop their own goals about speaking and stuttering. It's a day camp program that includes daily individual and group speech therapy and parent education.

Therapeutic activities will allow participants to learn about the phenomenon of stuttering; develop their own plan for practice; develop ways to manage the social and emotional challenges; and learn how to communicate to their parents about stuttering.
